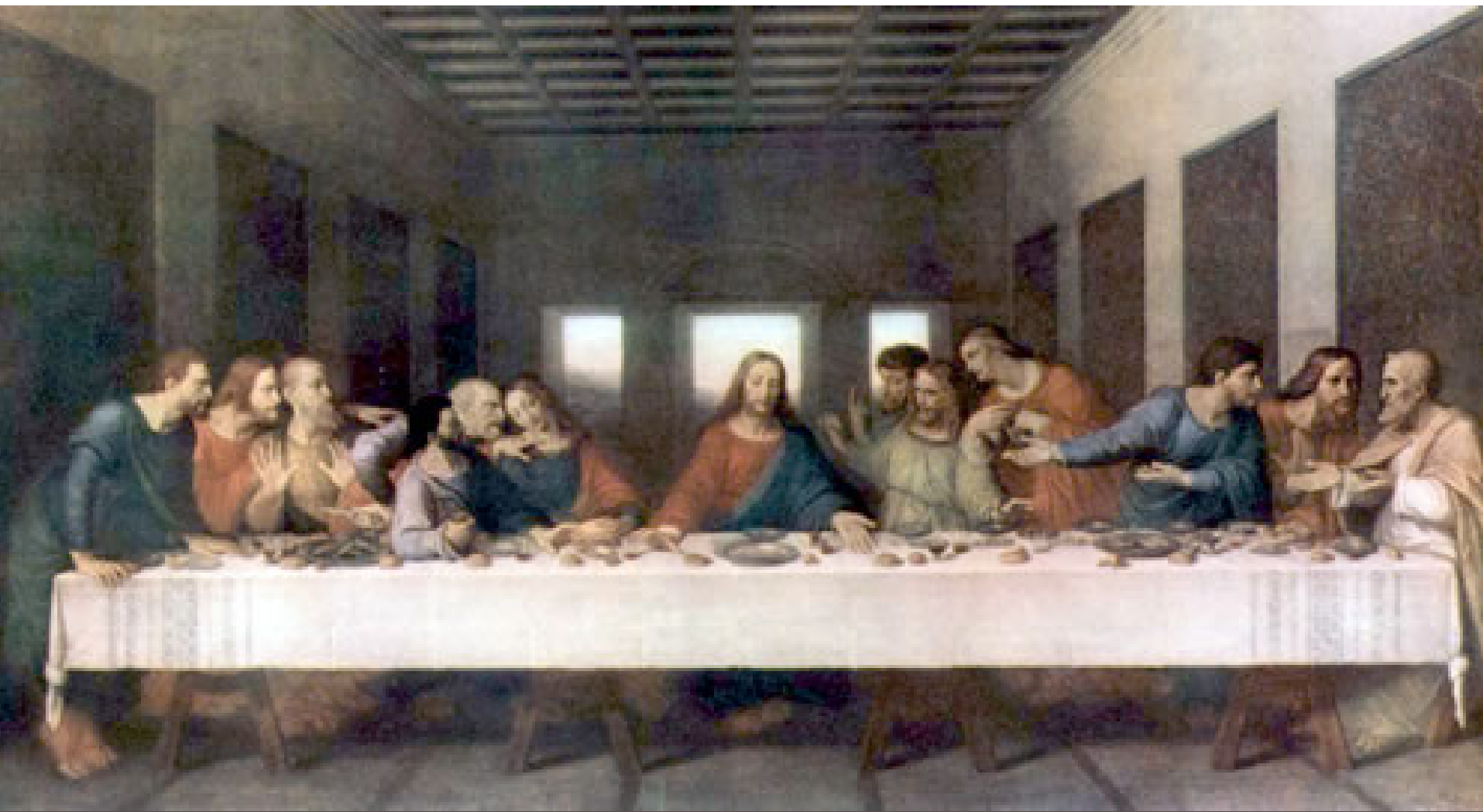

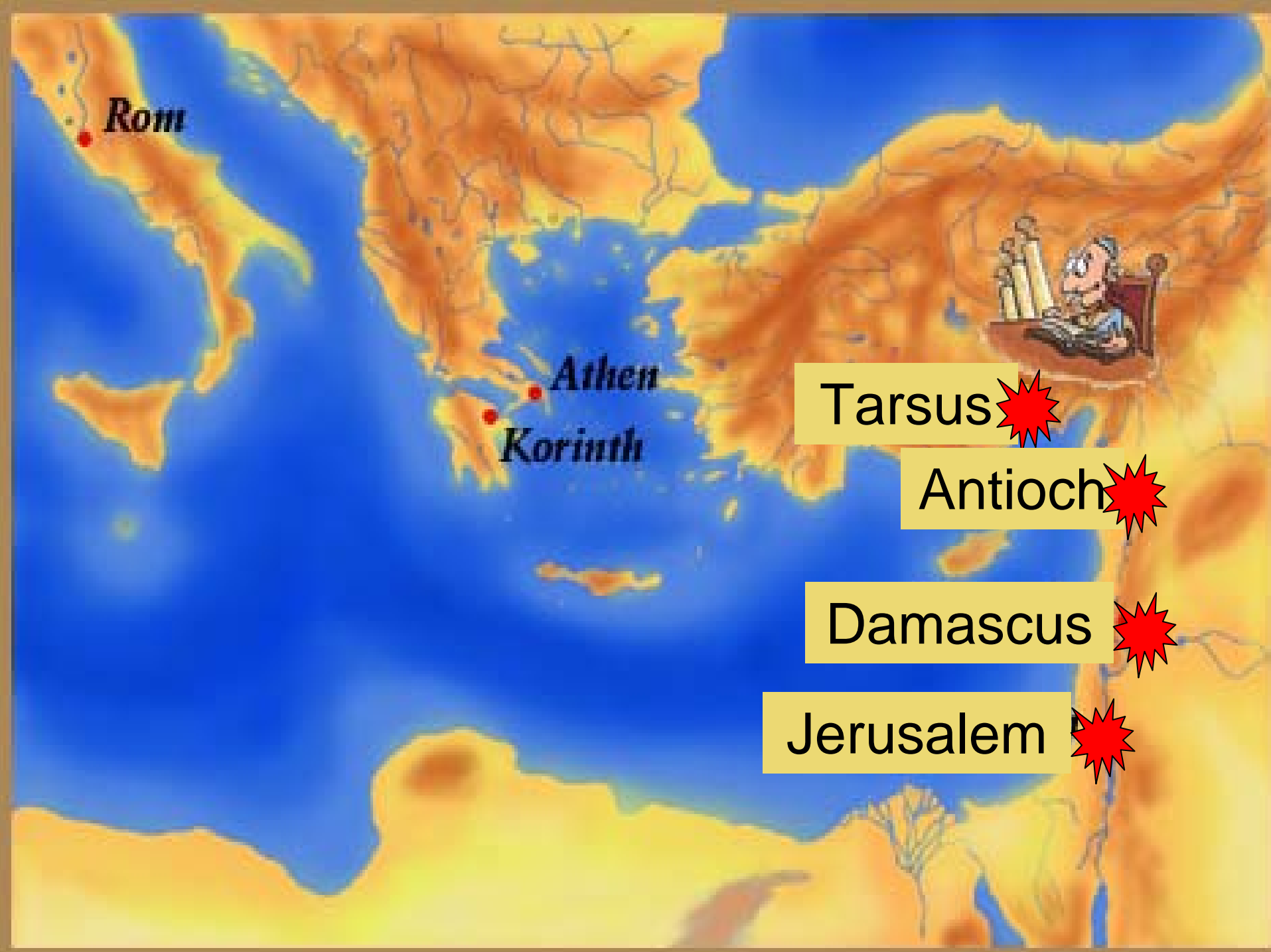

Barnabas goes to Tarsus to find Paul and together they teach “Christians” for a year





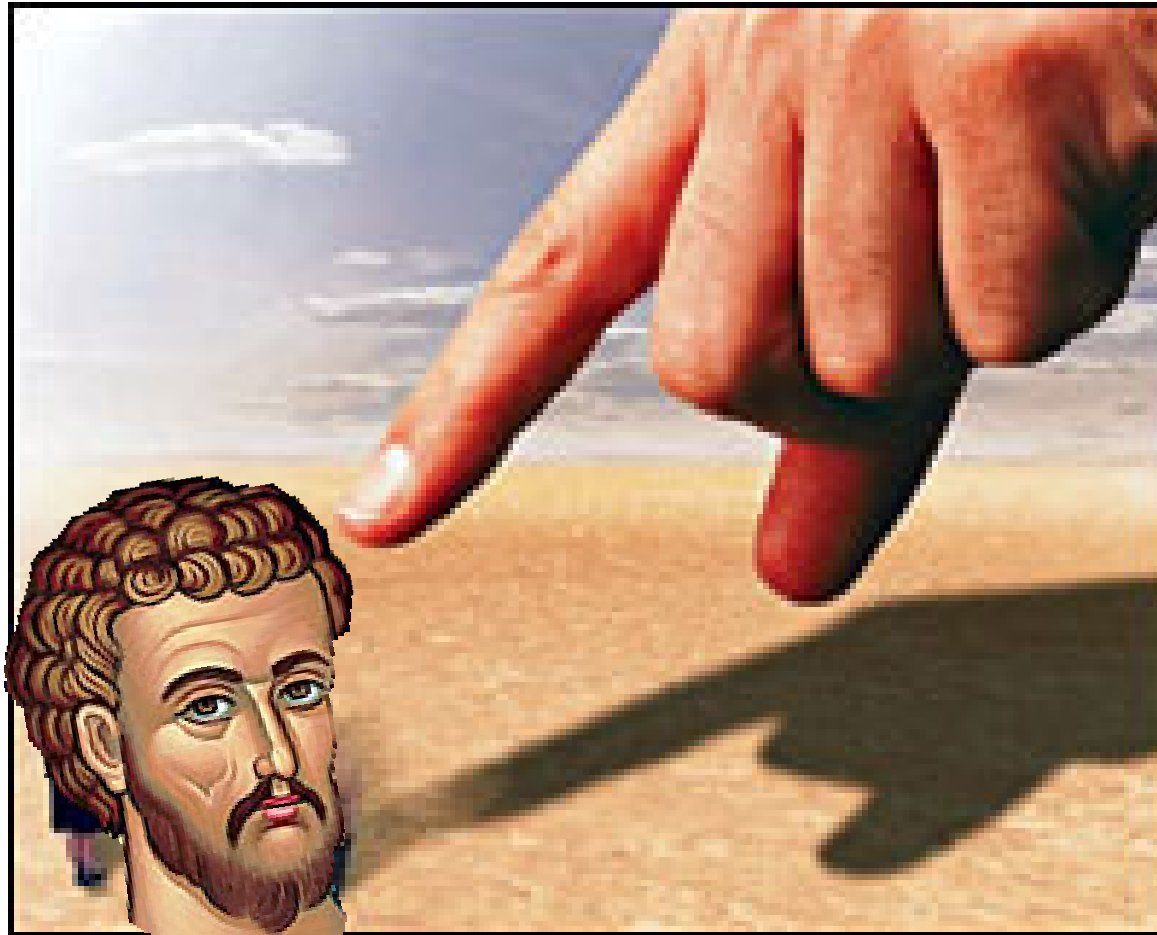

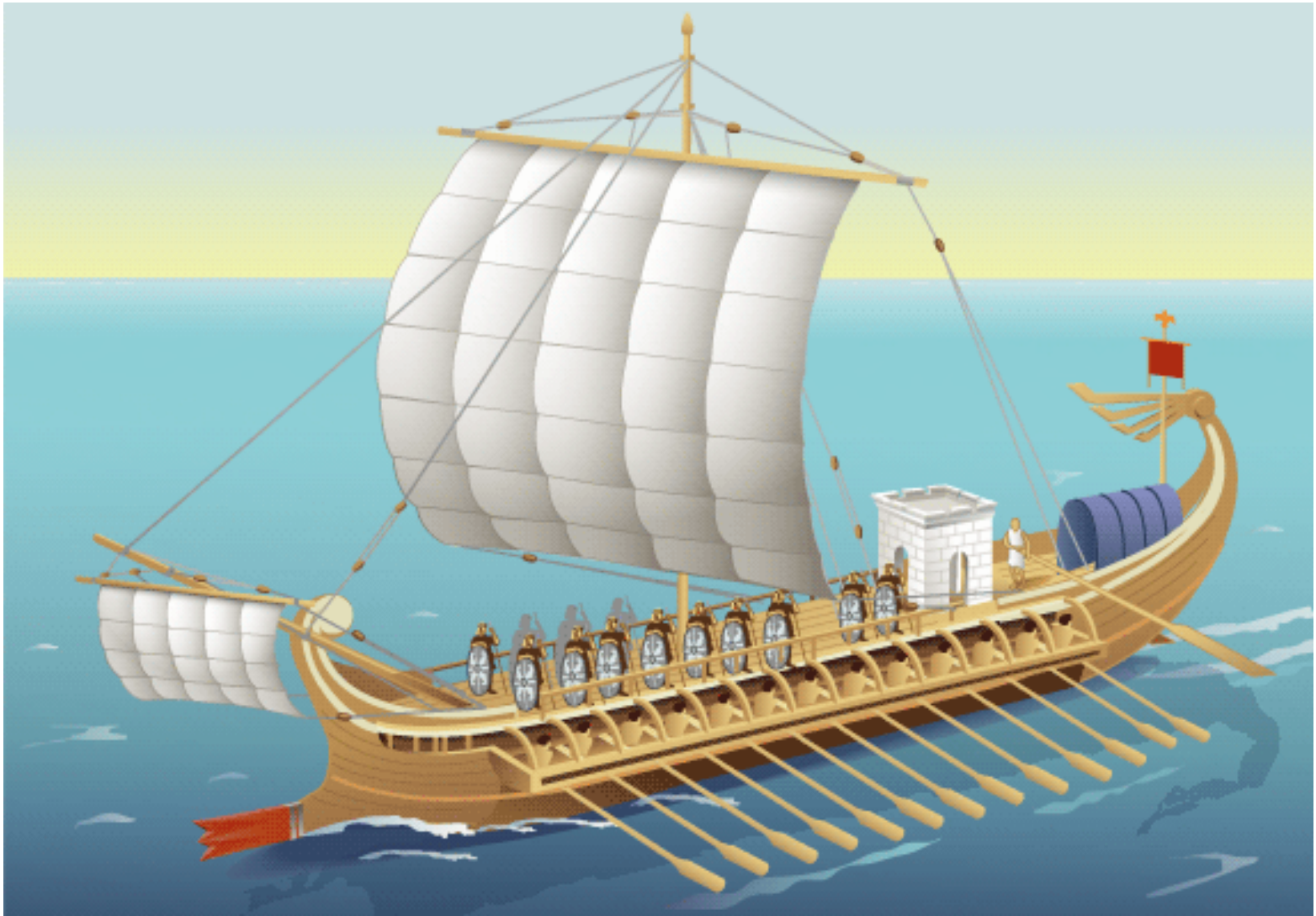
Trouble in Antioch!

(Gal 2:9)

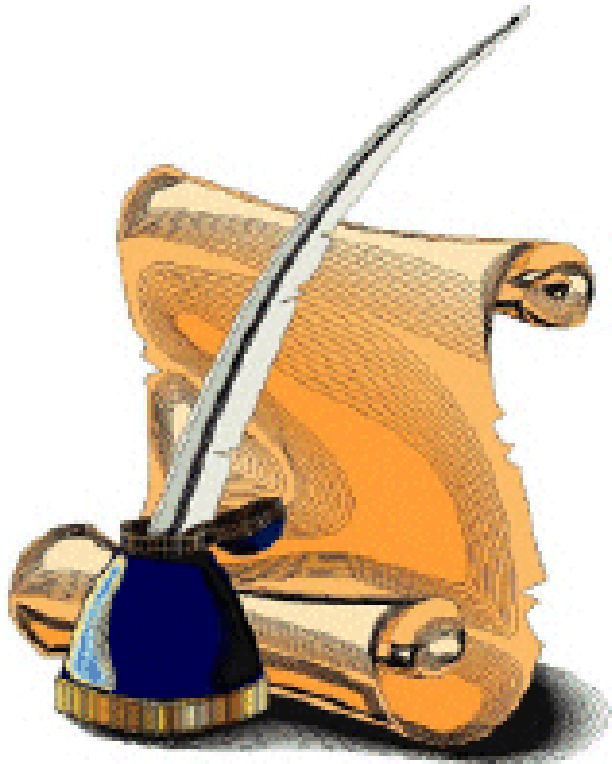
Paul “opposed him to his face” for conduct that “was not in step with the gospel” (Gal. 2:14)



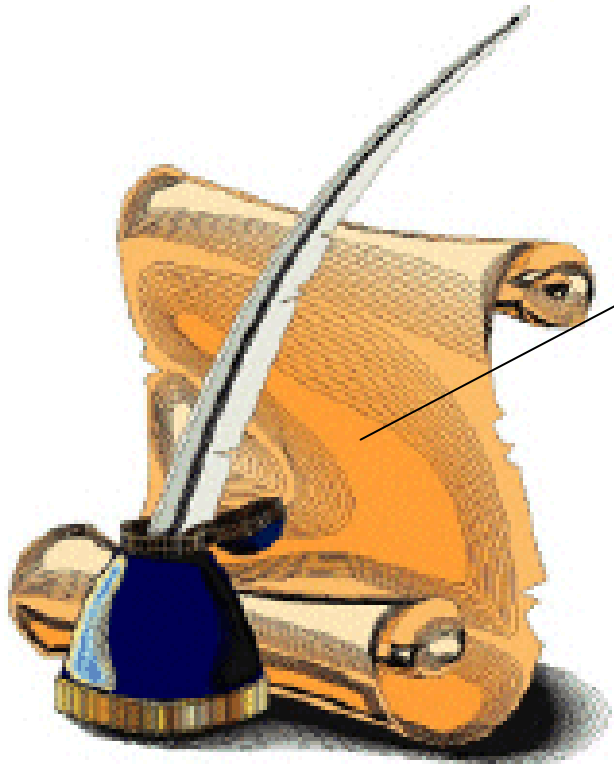
Paul gently helps and forgives,
